



Effluent Filters, Benefits, Use & Maintenance

Effluent filters are devices designed to protect your drain field from the scum and particles which can escape the septic tank and add solid waste to the drainfield. These particles accumulate and over time add to the biological organic (Biomat) that causes drain field percolation to slow and ultimately fall below the rate water is generated in the household.

As you can see, filters come in many shapes and sizes and are as versatile and customizable to your particular circumstances. The alarm below can even alert you when it is time to clean the filter.
